**Notes from VP National League**

1. **League panel ruling**

Deduct 4 points from HKYDT-B for failure to arrive in M4593.  
Deduct 2 points from HKYDT-B for a registered player playing down in the rescheduled game of M4593. Add 2 points to TKOBC-B for their lost to the offending team.  
Deduct 2 points from TMSA-B for a registered bowler playing down in W4554.  
Deduct 4 points from ILBC-D for failure to book the green in M4691.  
Deduct 4 points from WISC-A for failure to arrive in W4751.  
Deduct 2 points from KBGC-B for a bowler not wearing proper shoes in W4724. The case is also referred to disciplinary panel for follow-up.

2. **Premier League 2013**

Proposed schedule dates were issued with no feedback.  
Entry is now open. Entry deadline is 19 Feb.

3. **Auto allocation of Saturday evening for league games**

To minimize the overhead on rescheduled game, if the greens are fully occupied on Saturday afternoons, the rescheduled game will be automatically assigned to Saturday evenings. If the Saturday evenings are full, the outstanding games have to be rescheduled as current practice.

This auto allocation will be effective from premier league 2013.

# **REPORT ON THE 2012 World CHAMPIONSHIPS**

## **- to the Councilors of the Hong Kong Lawn Bowls Association**

### **1. INTRODUCTION**

The World Championships was held once in every four years. The tournament took place from 24 November to 9 December, 2012 at Lockleys Bowling Club and Holdfast Bay Bowls & Croquet Club, Adelaide, South Australia. Both venues were used for the Qualifying Round Competitions and all Quarters-Finals, Semi-Finals and Finals were took place at Lockleys Bowling Club. Both venues are located outside the Adelaide town centre, Team Manager would drive to the first venue from the apartment for 5 minutes and drop down half of the team and then drove to another venue for 15 minutes before each game starting at 0900 hrs. every day. Lockleys and Holdfast Bay each have four outdoor grass greens, with 6 or 7 rinks on each green. Except for a few days with cold winds and light showers, the weather in Adelaide was generally warm (up to 38 degrees), sunny and windy.

### **2. THE TEAM**

The team consists of 10 players plus two managers. They are

### **3. PREPARATION PRACTICE**

19 official practice sessions were arranged before departing HK. It helped the team to get together to enhance teamwork, build up trust and communication in particular to those new members.

### **4. FORMAT OF PLAY**

The tournament was played in traditional format of 4 disciplines. Participated countries were grouped in two sections according to the previous results. Each section played a full round robin, with top 3 countries qualified for quarterfinals, semi-finals and finals. The winner of section 1 will progress to semi final, the winner of section 2 will progress to section 2-semi final. The second and third placed teams from each section will be randomly draw into two post-sectional playoff matches, game A and game B. The winner of game A will progress to semi final 1, the winner of game B will progress to semi final 2. The winners of each semi final will play off in the final for the gold and silver medals. The losers of both semi finals will be awarded bronze medals. Time limits (3.5 hours) will apply to all games for all disciplines in sectional play only.

## 5. THE COMPETITORS

There was 27 competing countries participant the tournament. 24 countries competed in men's competition and 24 countries competed in women's competition. The participated countries were Australia, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei, Canada, China, Cyprus, England, Fiji, Hong Kong China, Ireland, Israel, Japan, Jersey, Malaysia, Namibia, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norfolk Island, Philippines, Scotland, South Africa, Spain, Thailand, USA, Wales and Zimbabwe.
