Entry Requirements for Visiting Sports Teams to Kowloon Cricket Club

On behalf the Kowloon Cricket Club (the Club), please take time to read through the information update and aware of the venue protocols details in below for away sporting team player entering the Club.

- 1. All visitors and visiting teams 'Enter & Exit' the Club via the Carpark entrance on Cox's Road and register at the Lawn Bowls green's registration station.
- 2. Player's body temperature must be passed under 37 degrees through the thermometer check for accessing into the Club. If the player's body temperature is checked over 37 degrees and the temperature machine raised up the alarm, the Club staff will refuse entry to the player, guest or spectator to the Club premises.
- 3. Health declaration form is a requirement protocol of the Club and all teams, visitors, spectators are required to sign. Clearly read the terms and conditions carefully and sign the health declaration form to acknowledge the requirement to access into the Club. All entrants must leave their name and contact details for the Club records. All personal information collected will be kept in strict confidence. HK SAR Government will have access if it is needed under Covid policy.
- 4. LeaveHomeSafe ("LHS") protocol must be adhered to for entry to the Club.
- 5. Players are required to follow the vaccination requirements and restrictions in line with the Government's latest policies. Personal vaccination record shall show to KCC official staff to verify for access into the Club premises.
- 6. Mask-wearing requirement must be observed by all visiting teams, guests and spectators. Players are exempted when playing, exercising and consuming food and beverage. According the Government regulation Cap.599I defined the mask includes any covering designed or made to be worn over the nose and mouth to provide the wearer protection against infections or air pollution
- 7. Social distancing must be observed by all visiting teams, guests and spectators keeping 1.5 meters apart avoid virus infection. Group gathering restrictions are subject to the Government regulation.
- 8. Team Players, Guests and Spectators Policy is subject to change by Club Management and visitors should check beforehand if there is any change to the Club policy.
- 9. Food and Beverage
 No outside food or drinks are allowed to be brought into the Club premise.
- 10. Smoking is permitted at the designed smoking area only.
- 11. Changing Room facilities is not available for visiting teams currently and is subject to change by Club Management.
