Yet another busy year for the Association. There was the usual keenly contested League and National Championships, new greens opening in Sha Tin, the move to new and more spacious accommodation and the Hong Kong International Bowls Classic.

The Association were fortunate to receive substantial sponsorship towards the Classic from Craigengower Cricket Club, who were celebrating their centenary, and this together with sponsorship from China Light & Power and a grant from the Hong Kong Sports Development Board enabled us to go ahead with confidence. The field was expanded to 24 teams, ten from overseas, one ladies team nominated by the HKLLBA a Hong Kong representative pair and 12 local Clubs. The lineup was, as usual, very strong and our own Noel Kennedy beat Bill Boettger from Canada in the singles final and Craigengower Cricket Club (David Tso and George Souza) beat the fancied South African pair (Donny Piketh and Neil Burkett) in the pairs final. A third win for George and another memorable competition for bowlers in Hong Kong.

Hong Kong also took part in the XVth. Commonwealth Games in Victoria, British Columbia, Canada, a report of which can be found elsewhere in this Year Book.

The National Summer and Winter Leagues were organised by the National League Panel under the Chairmanship of Brian Poynton. Thanks must be extended to Brian who, every Saturday during the Summer League programme, rushes home to collate the results so that they can be published in the Sunday newspapers and be in the hands of Conveners by late Saturday evening. They are proving successful, and from the interest generated together with the move of experienced bowlers who live in the area, to these new greens, it is hoped that two new Clubs will be formed during 1995.

The short mat game is still proving to be popular with coaching being provided to many areas of the Territory. As always thanks go to Noorie Razack and his team of coaches for all their hard work during the year both outdoors and indoors.

In conclusion I would like to thank our Sports Executive, Emmy Wong, who started work with both Associations in March. Emmy has brought a great deal of enthusiasm to the job. Our administration has not only improved but it has also reduced my workload with the Association.

Report of the Men's Manager XVth Commonwealth Games 1994

These Games, the last in which Hong Kong took part, were held between 18th and 28th August 1994. Apart from lawn bowls, the Games had 9 other official sports: aquatics, athletics, badminton, boxing, cycling, gymnastics, shooting, weightlifting and wrestling. Field lacrosse was a demonstration sport, and for the first time in Games history, disabled athletes were allowed to participate. For lawn bowls a visually impaired singles competition was organised.

The Hong Kong Team consisted of Ken Wallis (singles), Bill and Mark McMahon (pairs), Mel Stewart, Danny Ho, George Souza and Noel Kennedy (fours), and in the visually impaired singles Carlos Antunes was selected by the Hong Kong Sports Association for the Physically Disabled.

The team arrived in Vancouver on 11th August for acclimatisation and for the chance to practise at Vancouver South Lawn Bowls Club. On the 14th August the team made the short journey to Victoria Island and immediately moved into the University of Victoria which had been transformed into the Athletes Village. Over 3,500 athletes and officials were housed in the Village, therefore, living conditions were very cramped with 11 people being squeezed into a unit built for four.

The competition took place on the four greens of the Juan de Fuca Recreation Centre which was situated approximately 25 minutes drive from the Village. Unfortunately the greens were just recovering from a fungal attack, and therefore, were bumpy where repairs had been made. This caused a number of complaints from players and after 6 days of play one of the greens was closed down completely except for televised matches. All bowls were examined, green tested and recorded prior to the start of the competition. Whilst the Hong Kong team had no problems, a number of other countries had bowls rejected because they did not have the new 'bullet' type stamp on them. This caused a great deal of debate, especially by the countries affected, but no exceptions were given by the organisers, and so, suitable bowls had to be found from elsewhere.

A total of 22 countries took part. Unfortunately not all had a full team of 7 players, and therefore, each discipline had varying numbers of countries. All events were played in two sections with each section being played on a 'round-robin' basis. The composition of the sections was based on the overall positions in the World Bowls Championships 1992, i.e. the winning country was placed in section A and the runner-up in section B and so on. Countries not competing in the last World Bowls Championships were randomly placed into the sections. This arrangement produced a very unbalanced pairs draw, and even more debate.

There were three sessions per day at 8.30 a.m., 1.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. Disciplines had either one or two matches per day and most had at least one day of rest.

The singles competition had a full complement of countries and Ken was drawn in a section which contained fancied South Africa, Scotland, Jersey and Canada. Ken had a good start

beating Canada and then South Africa fairly comfortably, and despite defeats by Scotland, Guernsey and Wales along the way, Ken managed to keep second position in his section throughout the event to win a well earned bronze medal.

The pairs event had 18 countries and unfortunately Bill and Mark were drawn in the very strong section which included Australia, England, South Africa, Scotland, New Zealand and Canada. There were no easy matches and at the end of the day Bill and Mark won four of their eight matches, drew another and lost three to finish sixth in their section. They were only two points behind second place and with a little more good fortune along the way could have been in with a chance of a medal.

The fours had 20 countries and Hong Kong opposition included South Africa, Scotland and Northern Ireland. A good start, especially the game against Scotland, saw Hong Kong leading the section, but defeats by Cook Islands, Northern Ireland, Jersey and then South Africa meant that we ended in a disappointing fifth place in the section.

Only 6 countries contested the visually impaired singles competition. The bowlers had varying degrees of eye sight, and Carlos won a bronze medal.

Finally, I would like to thank Robert Lam of Technical Products International, Dr Louis Hsu, the President of Craigengower Cricket Club, Lawn Bowls East and Lydiard Shoe Co. in New Zealand for their generous sponsorship of the team.

The Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 1994

The 1994 Hong Kong International Bowls Classic should be remembered as the Craigengower Cricket Club Classic in view of the decision of the Club to encompass the Singles Event as part of its Centenary celebrations. The subsequent sponsorship by the CCC enabled the whole event to go ahead once again and with major contributions from the Hong Kong Sports Development Board, China Light & Power Co. Ltd. and Waco International Formwork and Access Systems Ltd., we were on the road again.

The Singles, this time entitled the Craigengower Centenary Souza Singles was played at CCC on Saturday and Sunday 5th and 6th November 1994 with an Opening Ceremony on the Saturday at which the President of CCC, Dr. Louis HSU officiated. A total of 64 players made the main draw following a local qualifying competition in September, and some of the Hong Kong representatives did exceedingly well. Young Graeme Parker of KCC saw off National Champion Bill McMahon and Will Thomas of Wales, Stephen Lo of CLP accounted for Rex Johnston of Australia and K.C. Ching of HKEGSC had a wonderful game against the reigning Champion Graham Robertson of Scotland. Other locals to win against overseas players were Y.L. Ha (CLBC), T. Abraham (CdeR), D. Ho (KCC) and Chan Hoi (HKEGSC). The quarter-finals however only saw S. Lo, O. Adam and N. Kennedy survive, with Noel going on to win well against A. Blair in the semi-final and B. Boettger in the final for a famous HK victory.

The Pairs commenced on Monday 8th November, returning across the harbour to KBGC and the round-robin format of old with two Sections of twelve teams each.

Round-robin play of such duration is a very interesting competition and it is often difficult to see qualifiers emerge until the final round, particularly when some teams are eyeing their potential quarter-final opponents.

In Section play Wales, CCC, Fiji and SA were always there, but it was perhaps surprising to see England, Ireland and Hong Kong fall by the way side. Israel the holders also qualified with relative ease without looking the force of the previous year and it was no surprise to see Commonwealth Games Champion Australian Rex Johnston account for them in the quarters. Fiji also failed to produce their best in the K.O. phase along with Wales who were defeated by HK's sole representatives, CCC. South Africa came through in a tough one against Scotland. In the semis S.A. with Neil Burkett supreme, comfortably disposed of Australia whilst CCC slipped though in a very tight game 21-20 against NZ.

The final, whilst not reaching the heights of the previous year, saw probably the week's in-form Skips Burkett and George Souza fight it out. Souza was obviously fired up to win this one in CCC's Centenary Year and with partner David Tso made it a Hong Kong quinella by sweeping home in relative comfort by 20-12.

After the dust had settled, we had witnessed yet another superb event, well run and well played in ideal weather. We look forward perhaps to another bonanza of bowls this year in early November.
