After finally securing a place from the WIBC for our qualifier in the World Indoor Championships in February, Tony Tong of HKFC was invited to participate. Tony won through in a qualifier at the end of last year held at CCC and HKFC. Undoubtedly this will be a great honour and experience for him.

I am again extremely fortunate to have had a very hardworking and enthusiastic team on the Association with Vincent Cheung and Brian Poynton continuing to deal with competitions and the leagues in their usual efficient fashion. On the international front, the ladies took part in the Sixth Pacific Bowls Championships and were able to bring back a bronze medal in the ladies Singles, won by Angela Chau. Congratulations are also extended to the men's Singles, Triples and Fours on winning bronze medals.

Report of the Hon. Secretary H.K.L.B.A.

1995 has once again been a busy, and successful year for the Association. For the first time in many years the number of member Clubs increased. After an absence of nine years the Correctional Services Department re-joined in October, Hongkong Land formed a bowls section within their sports association and joined in November, and Greende Lawn Bowls Club, started by members of other Clubs, applied to join in December. All three Clubs will use Siu Lek Yuen, Sha Tin as their home green.

Craigengower Cricket Club continued their sponsorship of the Classic, although not to the same amount as the year before. However, with their help, a grant from the Hong Kong Sports Development Board, and the very important decision by the General Committee to underwrite the event to an amount up to \$250,000, it just made it possible for the Classic to go ahead. The format was the same as last year, i.e. 24 teams. Ten from overseas, one ladies team nominated by the HKLLBA, a Hong Kong representative pair and 12 local Clubs. The quality of the field was as usual very strong with the Hong Kong pair (David Tso and Bill McMahon) making the semi-finals only to lose out to South Africa 23-14. Both finals were memorable with Noel Graham (Ireland) scrapping home against Neil Burkett (South Africa) 25-24 in a 32 end match after being 21-11 up, and Scotland (Alex Marshall and Ken Logan) defeating South Africa (Donny Piketh and Neil Burkett) 19-18 to make it a record fifth Classic pairs title for Scotland. A full report can be found elsewhere in this Year Book.

Hong Kong also took part in the Pacific Bowls Championships 1995 in Dunedin, New Zealand, winning three bronze medals and finishing third overall. This confirms Hong Kong as the number one lawn bowling nation in Asia. A report on the Championships can be found elsewhere in this Year Book.

The National Summer League regrettably is still without a sponsor. The number of teams participating reduced by one to 40 from the 14 member Clubs. Once again each Division was keenly contested with many teams battling to the end to either be promoted or avoid relegation. A total of 732 bowlers played in the league, and of that number 260 tried their hands at skip on at least one occasion. Congratulations to the respective Champions, Kowloon Cricket Club "A", Kowloon Cricket Club "B", Royal Hong Kong Police "C" and Hong Kong Football Club "C".

The National Winter League also proved to be competitive with 28 teams taking part, an increase of four over last year. Congratulations go not only to the respective winners, Kowloon Bowling Green Club "A",

Royal Hong Kong Police "A" and Hong Kong Football Club "B", but also to the individual discipline winners. Thanks as always are extended to the National League Panel and in particular its Chairman Brian Poynton, who does an outstanding job every Saturday evening collating results for the press and each Club.

The National Championships were organised by the National Championships Panel under the Chairmanship of Vincent Cheung. The weather was better this year than last and all events ran smoothly due to the fine work put in by Vincent and his Panel. Congratulations go to all the winners and finalists.

Training courses, run in conjunction with the Municipal Councils, continue to be held at Victoria Park and Sha Tin. Demand is as strong as ever at Victoria Park with courses held on Sundays and most days of the week. At Sha Tin, interest is slowly being generated and the numbers of courses are steadily increasing. As always thanks should go to Noorie Razack and his team of coaches for all their hard work throughout the year.

Our Sports Executive, Ms. Emmy Wong resigned at the end of July to join the Sports Development Board. The vacant post was advertised in the press to which 34 people applied. A short list was made and after interviews Ms. Casemen Wan was appointed as the new Sports Executive with affect from 16th August. Casemen worked previously for the Hong Kong Football Association and brings considerable experience to the post.

On the horizon, the Regional Council will open two new grass greens in Tai Po at the end of 1996. The Urban Council will also start construction in the middle of 1996 on an indoor sports complex that will accommodate a bowls green. Completion of this project is scheduled for June 1998. Although no time tables have been announced, the Regional Council is also considering outdoor bowling greens in Tsuen Wan and Tuen Mun. These new development schemes can only be good for the sport.

Sadly this is my last report as I will be leaving Hong Kong in June. I have enjoyed working for the Association in various positions over the last eight years and would like to thank everybody for their help and support. After a long period of little or no expansion in the sport, we are now seeing some improvement with more public facilities coming on stream. Much still needs to be done if lawn bowls is to develop further. Demands on the time of the Officers of the Association are ever increasing and I would call on more 'local' bowlers to help in the running of the sport. I wish the Association good luck for the future in this important and challenging time for Hong Kong.

'Excellence Award' from the Hong Kong Coaching Committee and her helpers for their invaluable time and effort put into the training and organization of the bowlers.

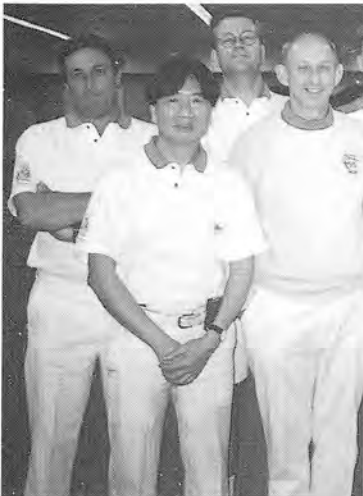

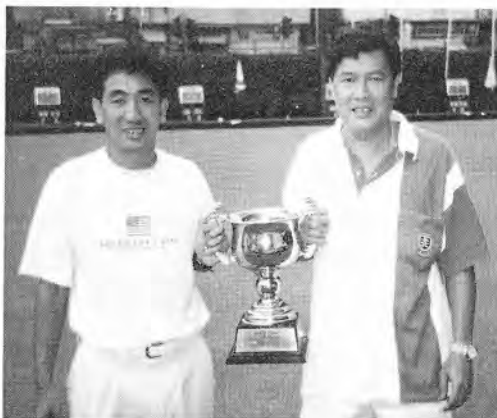

Report of the Men's Manager

6th Pacific Bowls Championships — Dunedin, New Zealand

The Championship was hosted by New Zealand Bowls Association at Dunedin between 22nd November and 2nd December 1995. The venue greens were the Logan Park Bowling Club, the Dunedin Women's Bowling Centre, Leith Bowling Club and Kaikorai Bowling Club. A total of fifteen countries took part in this Championships.

The Hong Kong Team consisted of Noel Kennedy, Danny Ho, Ken Wallis, Mel Stewart and new comer to the team Willie Lai, Noel played in the Singles and teamed up with Willie in the Pairs. Danny, Ken and Mel played in the Triples and teamed up with Willie in the Fours.

The team arrived in Dunedin in the evening of 17th November for acclimatization. They were met by their host club, the Kaikorai Bowling Club and were taken to their accommodation situated at the University College. Each team member was allocated a single room with breakfast and dinner provided. The accommodation was 10 minutes walk from the main venue and the surroundings were quiet. The standard of the accommodation was considered to be very satisfactory.

The competition commenced on Wednesday 22 November 1995. The format of play this time was changed to sectional play instead of the round robin held in the previous Championships. The top teams of each section played off the final for gold and silver whilst the second team of the sections became the joint bronze medallists.

In the Singles, Noel only lost one game to New Zealand, came second in his section and won a bronze medal. In the Pairs, Noel and Willie had a very good run and played their last game in the section against Australia to decide the sectional winner. They had a marginal lead over the Australians throughout the game for 17 ends but with the unfortunate few last ends, they lost the game by three shots, came second in the section and took bronze.

The Triples played well and were on a run for a medal. All they had to do was to win their last two games. In their second last game, they beat New Zealand, the eventual gold medalists, 17-12 and all they had left was to beat Western Samoa in the last game at Kaikorai Bowling Club. However, the incredible luck that the opposition skip had throughout the game deprived the Hong Kong Team from getting the bronze. This went to Papua New Guinea who came second in the section with a minus shots difference. It was considered extremely unlucky for the Hong Kong triple to miss a medal.

The Fours had a very good tournament with only one loss to New Zealand, came second in the section, and won a bronze medal.

Once again, everyone took home a medal and Hong Kong finished 3rd overall behind New Zealand and Australia. A creditable performance from the Hong Kong team of which everyone can be proud.

The Team arrived in Dunedin in the evening of 17th November for acclimatization and practice. The Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 1995

The 1995 Hong Kong International Bowls Classic went ahead due to major sponsorship from Craigenhower Cricket Club and the Hong Kong Sports Development Board, and after the input from other minor sponsors, the HK Lawn Bowls Association provided a substantial contribution. The exposure to international competition for 60-70 local players is the justification for the expense.

Australia declined the invitation to the event due to the clash with a new sponsored tournament, their own National Championships and the Pacific Games. This allowed a rotation of invitations and Zimbabwe and Channel Islands competed for the first time.

CCC were the host for the Singles event and after spending a lot of time and money on the second green were quite naturally keen that the whole event was at CCC. IRC had kindly offered to be the standby venue, but the decision was made to use the second green at CCC. The effect on the competition of a difficult green compared to a split venue will never be known.

A qualifying competition for local players was completed in September for 39 places which, with the international players, made 64 entries for the Classic Singles.

In the first round Ran Lakoon of HKFC beat the 1994 runner-up Bill Boettger with Simon Chan (RHKP), Pat Chan (CLP), Paul Foster (HKFC) being local players beating international opposition. Pat continued to show no respect for England beating David Ward and continued in the second round when he beat Commonwealth Games Bronze Medallist, Ken Wallis. Bill McMahon had an easy win over Ted Waterston of Canada joining Ran Lakoon, Oscar Adem and Noel Kennedy as HK players in the third round. Of these only Noel Kennedy was able to progress to the quarter finals where he lost to Neil Burkett of SA. At the bottom of the draw there was a very close match with John Ottaway (Eng) beating Alex Marshall (Scot) 25-24. A fine example of the consistent draw game prevailing against a player who uses power to get out of trouble. The semi-final match between Neil Burkett and Donny Piketh, both of SA, certainly gave enough confidence to make Neil 25-23 the favourite for the final. Noel Graham of Ireland beat John Ottaway 25-20 in another interesting game. The final was a superb game with much support for the supposed underdog Noel Graham who finally won 25-24. Perhaps the LBA should agree a local amendment to WBB law 73 (b).

The Pairs commenced on Monday 28th October at Kowloon Bowling Green Club, the format being the usual two sections of 12 with the top four in each section advancing to a knockout competition. From the singles competition, both SA and Ireland were considered to have a chance but it was noted they were both in the tougher of the two sections. Ireland lost their way with a loss of CdeR and a draw with HEGSC. HK results improved after David Tso took over as skip. New Zealand beat all the local teams and the difficult one SA but lost to HK, Ireland, Scotland and Wales. The last game on the Saturday morning NZ against Scotland became the decider with NZ losing and moving from second to fifth place. The section qualifiers were SA, Wales, HK and Scotland.

In the other section CI won all their games, Canada did not live up to their reputation and England struggled losing to KBGC and IRC. With a game left against Zimbabwe, England

needed to win and hope that CCC lost to Fiji or KBGC lost to RHKP. England beat second place Zimbabwe, CCC won and KBGC scraped a draw thus England failed to qualify for the second year running. The section qualifiers were CI, Zimbabwe, CCC and KBGC.

The pundits who claimed Section 1 was tougher were proved correct when SA, HK, Wales and Scotland all won their quarter final games. The HK v Zimbabwe game was the tightest. By this stage Scotland had decided that they were here to bowl as well as socialise and easily disposed of CI in the quarter final and Wales in the semi-final. SA proceeded to the final with a 23-14 win over HK. In the final, SA were in the lead for the whole game creeping ahead with Scotland grimly holding on. On the last end SA were one shot up and holding at least two, when Alex Marshall took the jack to give Scotland one shot but 1m from the jack. Neil Burkett with his last bowl probably played his worst bowl of the tournament at least 2m short whilst Alex drew in for a second to give Scotland a 19-18 win.

Another successful Classic with the addition of CI and Zimbabwe meaning that future organising committees will have a problem with rotation of invitations. The 64 entry Singles again proved very popular exposing 40 local players to international competition, an opportunity many would not otherwise get.

This year's Classic is scheduled for 2-10 November 1996 with major sponsors still being required.
