The past year has once again been another busy one for the Association. 2 more member Clubs Sha Tin Sports Club and Wayfoong Sports Club formed this year and joined the Winter League using Siu Lek Yuen, Sha Tin as their home green. With the new green in Tai Po open this year, it is expected that more member Clubs will be formed.

The Association are fortunate that a new major sponsor for the Classic, Manulife was found in the middle of the year. With the continuous support of another major sponsor Craigenhower Cricket Club and the grant from the Hong Kong Sports Development Board, the Classic 96 was able to go ahead. It is delighted to note that sponsor for Classic 97 has been secured with Manulife and preparation work has been commenced. Thanks must go to Brian Poynton and John Lunn for their effort. A full report of Manulife Classic 96 can be found elsewhere in this Year Book.

Hong Kong also took part in the 8th World Bowls Championship in Adelaide, Australia. A report on the Championship can be found elsewhere in this Year Book.

The National Summer League and Winter League were organised by the National League Panel. Thanks are extended to Panel members and its chairman Brian Poynton for the efficient organisation of both Leagues and collating results for the press and each club. The National Summer League and Winter League are still without a sponsor. The number of teams participating in Summer League is increased by 3 to 44 from the 17 member Clubs. A total of 862 bowlers played in the league, 130 more than last year. The format of Winter League was revised to 3 triples and in general been accepted. The number of teams participating is increased by 7 to 35 from the 19 member Clubs. A total of 485 bowlers played in the league, 63 more than last year. Congratulations to the respective winners:-

Amy Mok was appointed as the new Sports Executive with effect from 15 February. 1997 is a very significant one for Hong Kong. With a hope to spread the sport to the mainland, I would call on more 'local' bowlers to help in the running of the sport in this important and challenging time for Hong Kong.

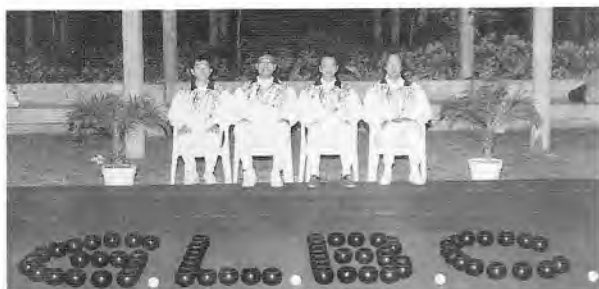

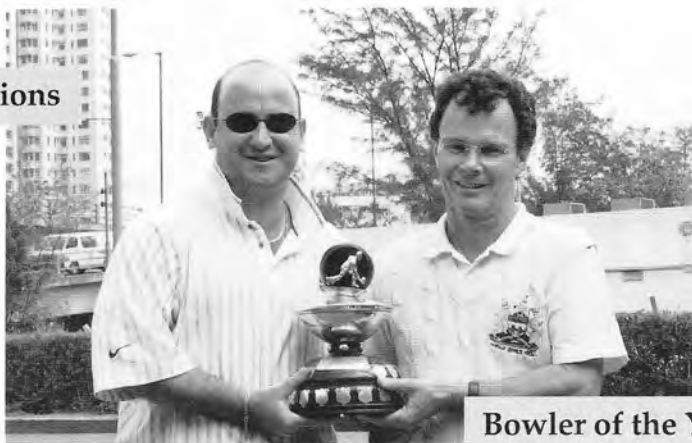

## **Report of the Men's Manager**

### **8th World Bowls Championships — Adelaide, Australia**

The Championship was held in Adelaide, Australia between 18 and 31 March 1996. The venue green was the Lockleys Bowls Club which consisted of four greens. A total of thirty countries took part in this competition.

The Hong Kong team line up was exactly the same as the Pacific Bowls Championship last year. Noel Kennedy played in the Singles and teamed up with Willie Lai in the Pairs. Mel Stewart, Ken Wallis and Danny Ho played in the Triples and teamed up with Willie Lai in the Fours.

The team departed Hong Kong on 8 March for Brisbane where they had three practice games with the Queensland State players at the Wavell Height Bowls Club, The New Farm Bowls Club and the Mooloolaba Bowls Club.

The team arrived in Adelaide on 14 March where they were met by the host club, the Beaumont Bowls Club, and taken to their accommodation. On the same evening, the Mayor of Burnside City greeted the team welcome by staging a cocktail party. On the evening of 15 March, an official welcoming party was held at host club where every member of the team were presented with a World Bowls medal.

The accomodation was the Haven Motel Inn situated at the Waterfront of Glenelg City and was about ten minutes drive from the venue. Double room was provided and the surroundings were quiet and convinient.

The competition commenced on 18 March. 30 countries were divided into four groups and only the top team of each group were qualified for the medals play-off.

The Pair lost two games to Ireland, the eventual gold medalist, and New Zealand. Came third in the section and eighth overall. The triples lost four games, came fourth in the section and 16th overall.

In the Singles, Neol lost only one game to Tony Alcock of England, came second in the section and 7th overall. However, the lost was a bit unfortunate as Noel was at one time 24-15 up over Alcock. There were several chances for Noel to finished the game but the luck and skill from Alcock deprived the medal from Noel. Alcock went on to win the championship. In the Fours, we came second in the section and 9th overall. Once again, if they had won their last game against PNG, they would became top and advanced into the semi-finals.

It was a bit unlucky for the Hong Kong team to come home without a medal. Everybody tried very hard and, though they missed out the medals, they attained the 9th overall position which proved that Hong Kong is still within the top ten in the world. A rather satisfactory result and achievement.

# The Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 1996

HongKong in November has become one of the first entries in the Dunwoodie Diary since I first covered the event back in 1989.

Aussie duo Rex Johnson and Trevor Morris took the pairs title that year with New Zealand's Peter Belliss taking the singles and completing a clean sweep for the Southern Hemisphere.

Since then the Classic has grown from strength to strength and is now regarded as the world's top pairs event.

Like many events worldwide, the Classic Organising Committee haven't always found it easy to secure the funding required for an event of this magnitude, but with a new sponsor last year - Manulife Regent, the 1996 event proved to be the best ever, and with the continued support of the sponsor the Classic looks to have a bright future.

The main title - the pairs, went at long last to South Africa with Gerry Baker and Neil Burkett grabbing the spoils with a 24-20 win over New Zealand's Andrew Curtain and David File.

Having lost out in the final for the three previous years, no-one can argue that the South African victory hadn't been well deserved. They had more than paid their dues after losing to Scotland in the 1995 final, Craigengower Cricket Club's David Tso and George Souza in '94 and Israel's Cecil Bransky and Jaff Rabkin in '93.

The South African's got a dream start in the final with a count of six on the opening and that helped them to a 15-5 lead after nine ends. The Kiwis hit back and five ends later they were only one down at 15-16, but Baker and Burkett finished the stronger to wrap up the title.

In the earlier semi-finals, South Africa had recovered from 4-12 down after eight ends to beat Aussies Andrew Waddell and John Noonan 20-18, while the New Zealand duo ended Andy Wills and Stuart Airey's hopes of giving England their first win in the event when they came through 22-13.

Local hopes had faded at the quarter final stage where the HongKong Lawn Bowls Association side of Willie Lai and Anthony Carstairs went down 17-27 to New Zealand, while the HongKong side of Bill McMahan and Noel Kennedy saw a great fightback just fail to give them victory over the Australians.

McMahan and Kennedy trailed 1-11 after six ends, but recovered to lead 16-14 with four to play, before Australia hit back to snatch their 19-17 win.

England reached the last four stage with a 24-12 win against Ireland's Jeremy Henry and Noel Graham while defending champions Scotland bowed out when Kenneth Logan and Alex Marshall lost 12-17 to the eventual winners.

The singles event, against hosted by Craigengower Cricket Club, produced its usual two days of frantie activity and the quality of the invited overseas players was borne out with seven of them reaching the quarter final stage.

The odd one out was HongKong's Bill McMahan and he moved through to the last four with a 25-11 victory over Ireland's World Pairs Gold Medallist Jeremy Henry.

Gerry Baker got the better of his South African partner Neil Burkett 25-17, while defending champion Noel Graham from Ireland survived a real battle before edging out Zimbabwe's Bill Cumming 25-23, with Aussie John Noonan coasting to a 25-7 win over England's Andy Wills.

Both semi-finals produced 25-17 scorelines, with Noonan ending Graham's reign, and Baker accounting for McMahon.

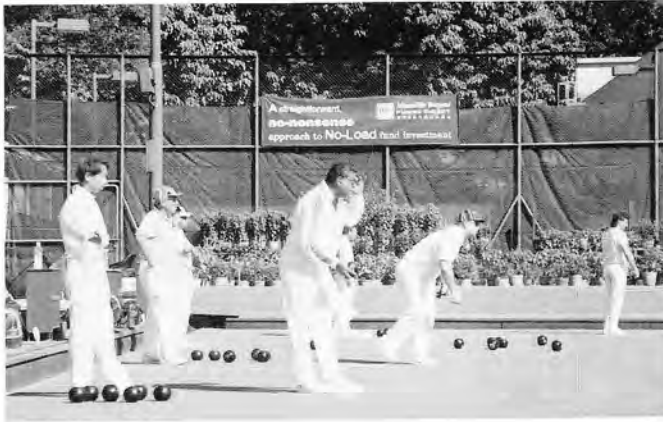
Most pundits were tipping a Baker victory in the final and when he raced into an 8-1 lead after just five ends their confidence looked justified.

However they had reckoned without a great rally from Noonan that saw him pick up thirteen shots over the next five ends, including two successive fours, to move ahead 14-8.

With twenty-three ends played, the title was up for grabs with the scores tied at 22-22, but it was the man from Adelaide who claimed the glory when a single and a double took him to a 25-22 victory.

It all added up to nine hectic days of bowls activity, with the world's best parading their skills in front of the HongKong bowls faithful, ensuring that the future of the Classic looks bright.
