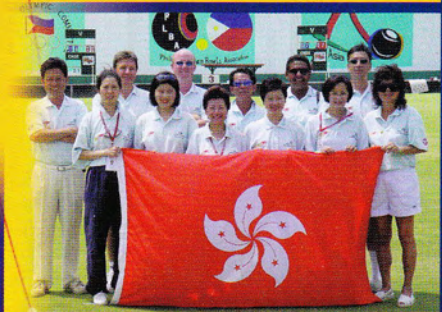

在不知不覺之間，二零零二年轉瞬已經過去。在年內總會的工作一如以往地繁忙，期間亦發生了不少對總會有重大影響的事件。

首先，在年初的時候兩名女仕獲選為總會的副會長。在12月，服務總會多年的副會長兼主裁判彭德離開香港返回英國，令我們損失了一位對發展香港草地滾球作出極大貢獻的好朋友。我在此謹向彭德致以最大敬意，感謝他對我們的國際草地滾球精英賽及聯賽所作的貢獻。

年內亦有兩個新球會加入了香港草地滾球總會的大家庭，我亦希望借此機會讓各位女性球手明白，總會的大門是永遠會為她們打開的。

在球場上，肯尼迪繼續在室內場地表現出色，亦多次在國際賽事取得佳績。另一好手賈士達在年中離開香港，雖然令香港的實力大為削弱，但亦為一眾新進球手帶來代表香港的機會。雖然大部份女子球手都已參加了香港草地滾球總會主辦的聯賽及其他比賽，但在選拔代表隊參加第二屆亞洲草地滾球錦標賽時卻仍然出現了一些紛爭，但最終由總會派出的男女子隊在比賽中的表現極佳，成績僅次於馬來西亞名列亞軍。我們現在已集中資源，將目標放於今年11月在香港舉行的亞洲太平洋草地滾球錦標賽。

香港草地滾球的前途亦一片光明，這可從一些新球會及青年軍在聯賽的表現反映出來。現在，香港卒之可以派出代表角逐世界室內25歲以下錦標賽。我特別在此鳴謝參與培訓青年軍的教練，我亦期望在不久將來我們可以成立一支女子青年軍。

另一方面，我們亦積極協助中國大陸球手爭取國家承認草地滾球運動的地位，而世界草地滾球組織對其進展亦極為關注。

我借此機會鳴謝各位委員會成員、聯賽委員會及公開賽委員會成員、遴選委員會成員、各球會的召集人、裁判及教練等，多謝他們在過去一年的貢獻。此外，我特別多謝九龍草地滾球會及紀利華木球會的委員及會員，感謝他們在國際草地滾球精英賽中所提供的協助。我亦多謝其他曾提供場地予我們舉辦公開賽的球會，而最重要的就是要多謝香港康體發展局對總會的財政及行政支援。

最後，我衷心祝賀今晚各位得獎者，希望各位都享受一個愉快的晚上。

For the first time in a number of years we can send players to represent Hong Kong China in the Under 25 World Indoor Championships. My thanks go to the coaches involved in the player's development and I look forward to the day when we have a girl's team in the league.

Away from the green we continue to assist the mainland bowlers in their efforts to have the sport recognised officially. World Bowls Ltd is also very interested in the outcome of our efforts.

I am grateful to the members of the general committee, league and national championship panel members, club convenors, umpires, selectors and coaches for their contribution and support during the past year. My thanks to the committee and members of KBGC and CCC for their continued sponsorship of the Classic and the clubs who provide the greens for national championship games. Last but by no means least my sincere thanks to the Hong Kong Sports Development Board for their financial and administrative support.

## 2nd Asian Lawn Bowls Championships 2002

The 2nd Asian Bowls Championships was held at Angeles City, Philippines between May 6-12, 2002. Participating teams were Brunei, China, Hong Kong China, Korea, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Singapore.

The Hong Kong Men's team was represented by Adam Poynton in the Singles who teamed up with James Cheng in the Pairs. The Triples were Harry Thornton, Jimmy Chiu and Loy D' Souza. The line up for the Fours were Harry Thornton, Jimmy Chiu, Loy D'Souza and James Cheng.



The Hong Kong Ladies team had Anna Clarke playing in the Singles with Danna Chiu as her partner in the Pairs. Triples were Camilla Leung, Stephanie Chung and Hannah Ha. Fours line up was Camilla Leung, Danna Chiu, Stephanie Chung and Hannah Ha.

### Men's Singles

Adam started off losing 13-21 to Malaysia, then went on to beat Korea and Singapore by 21-6 and 21-11. He lost his fourth game to China by 14-21 but made a come back by defeating Thailand and Philippines 21-18 and 21-9. When he played his last game against Brunei, there was still a slight chance of winning the gold medal if he could beat Brunei by 11 shots. At one stage, Adam was leading 20-11 with no hope of winning the gold but still needed to win to secure a silver. However, a strong come back from the Brunei player saw Adam lose the game 20-21. However a defeat for the Malaysian and Singaporean in their games helped Adam win silver on shots.

### Men's Pairs

The Pairs lost their first game to Malaysia by 6 shots then went on to win their next five games in a very comfortable manner. Unless they lost by more than 35 shots to Brunei, the silver medal was theirs. They lost by 3 shots to Brunei and ended up with a Silver medal 4 points behind the gold medalists, Malaysia.

### Men's Triples

The Triples were also beaten by Malaysia in their first game. They came back to win their second game over Korea but lost the third to Singapore. They made a good come back by winning their last four games and ended up in with Silver on better shot difference over Singapore.

### Men's Fours

The four lost their first game to Malaysia by one shot. They beat Korea, Singapore and China in the following three games but suffered a surprise defeat to Thailand in their fifth. On their last game, they needed to beat Brunei or else end up with a Bronze. A tight game ensued and saw Hong Kong beating Brunei by one shot to win the Silver medal.

### Ladies Singles

This was perhaps the most unlucky tournament for Anna Clarke in her many International matches. She ended up with two wins and came fifth overall. Her most unlucky number was 18 and on many occasions, she just had to trail the jack to win the game but it always bounced off something and ended up in a position which gave her opponent the chance to win. If luck had been on her side, she could have won three more games and ended up with a Silver medal.

### Ladies Pairs

Having only one win during the tournament was the most surprising and disappointing result for Anna and Danna who won a Silver at the Asia Pacific Championships in Australia last October. The total shot difference of -25 showed that nothing went their way throughout the tournament.

### Ladies Triples

The Triples drew with Malaysia in their first game. Had a comfortable win over Korea in their second game by 30 shots but lost to Singapore by 3 shots in their third game. After a bye, they went on to win their last three games over Thailand, Philippines and Brunei and ended up with a Silver medal.

### Ladies Fours

The ladies fours lost their first game to Malaysia but won all the other five. They ended up with the same points as Malaysia but missed the gold medal on shot difference.

## Hong Kong International Bowls Classic 2002

23 - 30 November 2002

*The Hong Kong Classic took place once again in the autumn at both Craighower Cricket Club and Kowloon Bowling Green Club. The overseas players arrived on the Wednesday and Thursday before the event and got down to the social side before focusing on the bowls. For the UK-based players this was the first time they had played outdoor for a while, but they soon found the speed of the greens to their liking.*



Early in the morning of the first Saturday, 24 players took to the greens to start the 2002 Classic. Defending champion Jason Greenslade of Wales played on rink A1 and got off to a winning start against Colin Nam. South African Clinton Roets got beaten by local youngster Robin Chok in a tight battle 21-18, while Chi Chi Fernandes was up to his old tricks by taking out Hong Kong representative Nelson To and then Brunei's Hj Naim Brahim. Other notable results in the first round included Terence Li beating Philippines player Brent Chamberlain, Bernard Leung of KBGC ousting Robert Horgan and Adam Poynton coming back from the dead to beat Robert Newman in a tense battle.

Moving through the rounds, the overseas players came to the fore with newcomer Barry Browne of Ireland beating Jason Greenslade and Amir Yaron of Israel beating Willie Lai who had earlier taken the scalp of Australia's Kelvin Kerkow. The two Scotsman George Sneddon and David Peacock eased through, as well as two past champions in Noel's Kennedy and Graham of KBGC and Ireland respectively.

The quarter-final line-up on the second morning saw only one local player while only one player from the southern hemisphere survived, Tom Ellem of Australia. The closest of these matches was between Noel Kennedy and Barry Browne with the number-11 player on the indoor rankings coming through to set-up an encounter with David Peacock, who was making his first appearance in the Classic. The other half of the draw saw two past champions easing through and giving the chance of an all-Scotland final. In all the years of the Classic two players from one invited country had never played each other in the final. This became a reality and for the final both players were asked to use coloured bowls to help spectators. The final was an epic battle with Peacock always being ahead and looking the likely

winner. He eased away towards the end to record a 21-13 victory and add another Scottish players name to the list of winners of the Souza Singles.

With the weekends play completed the next event for the players was the pairs at KBGC. There were no real favourites although the New Zealand pair of Russell Meyer and Paul Girdler had won many other events together, and Kelvin Kerkow and Tom Ellem were both playing well and getting used to the slower greens. The British players also had good pairings and defending champions Scotland had proved this with their performance in the singles.

From the first game it looked as though the overseas teams would again dominate the proceedings with the local clubs only producing the occasional shock result. This seemed true as New Zealand rattled through their sectional games allowing England to take a point of them in a drawn game. The English boys, Greg Moon and Robert Newman only lost one game to finish second in the section behind the Kiwis. South Africa and Wales filled the other two qualifying spots with all the other teams taking points of each other not really mounting a challenge to be in the running to finish in the top four. China who were playing for the first time in the pairs event produced some good bowls and showed that in the future they could certainly be a force to be reckoned with. The local pairing of Harry Thornton and Dawood Karamdin did not have a lot of luck and finished with three



wins from their 11 games. Hong Kong Football Club's Gerry Shirley and Alan Hutcheson, who became known as 'Starsky and Hutch', had a thoroughly good time ... off the green ... and were involved in the highlight of the week when a bowl of Gerry's rolled over a pigeon who had stopped for a feed on their rink.

The other section went along the same lines, with Australia losing one game and topping the section while Ireland and Scotland both lost two games. The other national teams in the section were Hong Kong and Malaysia and neither pairing really got going and allowed CCC to qualify

for the quarter-finals. Willie Lai is making the Classic a favourite tournament of his after playing in the final of the singles previously and again making the last eight in the pairs. The HK Youth Team who had to qualify to play in the event had a very good week and with a little more luck or a little more patience and composure (which comes with experience) could have been battling for a place in the quarter-finals. Jerry Ng and Ken Chan also kept changing positions and this gave them different experiences against high quality opposition. The Philippines team found themselves a little bit out of depth but will take heart from their first appearance at the annual event. They are still in the process of learning the game and the more chances they get to play in international events the more they will progress.

The quarter-finals took place on the Friday evening for the first time. This was to allow the overseas players the chance to fly out on the Sunday and get back home earlier, especially as some had other events to play in. New Zealand had a struggle against local opposition CCC and only won on the last few ends. South Africa overcame the Irish and England totally out bowled their northern neighbours Scotland to set up a semi-final against the Australians who produced a clinical display against Wales.

The weather deteriorated over the week and never really improved and made the greens very wet and this should really have been to the advantage of the UK teams but it was the Australasian teams who won the battles and set-up an Australia versus New Zealand final. With both Kiwis actually playing their bowls in Australia all four players knew each others game. Again coloured bowls were used and Meyer and Girdler started off the best with the new bowls and never looked







back. The final was very one-sided and the Australians admitted defeat before the regulation 21 ends could be played. A 33-13 score line showed how well the Kiwis adapted to the conditions and the change of bowls.

Before the event the New Zealand team manager had been reported as saying he was not happy with the pair's performance at the Commonwealth Games and a good showing in the Classic would be needed. Russell and Paul showed they can produce the bowls and went through the tournament undefeated, only the second time this has been done. A good week was had by all - both on and off the greens. With the Asia Pacific being held in Hong Kong in 2003 the Classic will be put on hold for one year.

See you in 2004 for the best outdoor invitational tournament in the world.

In 2001, the first youth team was formed from school students introduced to the sport by a joint schools and this Association's programme. The team (Youth Team (A)), comprising 17 youths aged from 13 to 20 years, has had regular training and last year joined the adults in the inter-club league and national competitions, managing to hold their own and win games. They were placed 4th in the 2001/2002 lowest division of our fours league but improved phenomenally to win the last season's premier fours league by 11 points, so will be promoted to Division 4 this coming season. They were also Division 5's Champion Rink and Best Skip nos. 1 and 8, (J. Ng and K. Chan). Some have also teamed up with experienced adult members in our National Competitions and won some rounds of the competitions, with one member (J.
