# HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL BOWLS CLASSIC 2013



The 2013 Classic continued its tradition to feature a talented line-up from top bowling nations of the world. Men's world no.6 James Talbot from Ireland and women's world no.4 Val Smith from New Zealand were amongst the internationals from Australia, Canada, China, England, Ireland, Japan, New Zealand, Philippines, Scotland, Singapore, Thailand and Wales.

Heading the Hong Kong contingent were 2012 World Champion of Champions runner-up Stanley Lai partnering Li Ming Sum; and one of Hong Kong's most experienced bowler Angela Chau leading rookie Dorothy Yu in the women's section.

Like the previous year, the semis and finals held at the Kowloon

Bowling Green Club were broadcast live on pay TV and on the Internet to broaden the viewership of the event. The other supporting venues were Kowloon Cricket Club, United Services Recreation Club and Club de Recreio.

The Men's Singles title went to 25-year-old England youngster Richard Catton on his Hong Kong debut. In fact, this was Catton's first tournament out of the European continent.

Catton defeated Stanley Lai at the televised men's singles under the backdrop of spontaneous drizzles and

an overcast sky. On his way to the Final, Catton beat a number of strong bowlers including top Hong Kong bowler Ken Chan, Irishman Gary Kelly, Uthen Ontong from Thailand and Richard Girvan from New Zealand.

It is noteworthy that Hong Kong bowlers made history by having representatives in all four Quarter-finals. Ken Chan was ousted by Catton at this stage, while Heron Lau was defeated by Richard Girvan. On the other side of the draw, Stanley Lai and Raymond Ho both progressed to the Semi-finals and guaranteed that there would be a local player in the Final.

Lai defeated Ho in a tight game to become only the third Hong Kong Chinese finalist, after Willie Lai of Greende Lawn Bowls Club and Heron Lau of Kowloon Bowling Green Club.

The Final was another tight affair and they were tied at 6:6 with only the last end to play. Both players drew close to the head with the first bowl and Catton trailed the jack to hold a shot when Lai had only the last bowl to play. Lai tried to draw, but the bowl stopped a metre in front.

After narrowly winning the first set, Catton played with great confidence, but Lai was also determined to come from behind. The two players displayed a high level of skill throughout.





In the eighth end, when the score was tied, Lai drew the first bowl within 20cm of jack, but Catton trailed the jack to hold the shot. Lai missed his running shot and Catton added two more to win the game.

Lorraine Malloy from Scotland, a Quarter Finalist in the 2012 Classic Singles and who had represented Scotland in the 2010 Commonwealth Games, took a giant step forward by winning the singles title on her second attempt. Malloy became the second Scottish woman to win the trophy since it was introduced in 2008.

Her success was probably all the more sweeter as she took revenge over Sonia Bruce from the Philippines, who had

dumped her out of the competition in the last 16 in 2012. After defeating Bruce in the third round, Malloy went on to beat local player Candy Leung from Kowloon Bowling Green Club and Australian youngster Carla Odgers to reach the Final, where she faced Maila Witheridge from the Philippines.

Witheridge, who bowled superbly in the earlier rounds and ousted Val Smith from New Zealand in their Semi-final, dominated the first set and finished it comfortably with a scoreline of 10:4.

In the second set, Witheridge suddenly lost the touch after leading briefly at the first three ends. Malloy took the chance to get two shots in each from the next four ends to force the game into a

three-end tie-breaker.

During the tie-breaker Witheridge failed to re-group and lost all three ends, conceding seven shots on the way.

The changing pace of the green during the day had made the game more difficult to play for all players. It was the rain in the morning which made the green heavy, then the wind dried up the green, forcing all to keep adapting to the green situation.

Whereas Catton did it on his first try and Malloy on second attempt, it was third time lucky for Scottish bowler Iain McLean in Men's Classic Pairs.

The reigning Scottish Open champion





McLean finally got his hand on the ultimate trophy after two close finishes, winning the men's pairs title with compatriot Robert Grant.

McLean, who finished runner-up in 2010 and was third last year, did not have the best of performance in the round-robin stage, losing four consecutive games from round six to nine, against Hong Kong, Ireland, Concordia and Craigenower Cricket Club.



Into the last round of the group stage, about half of the teams could qualify for the knock-out stage. The Scottish team beat Kowloon Cricket Club in the last game to take pole position of the group.

They went on to dispatch Hong Kong Police's Andy Chan and Boris Choi, the only local team left in the competition, at the Semi-finals and set up a Final with New Zealand, which did it the hard way by beating Australia and England en route to the Final.

The first set of the Final was a tight affair and was tied at 7:7 with only

the last end to play. The Kiwi skipper Richard Girvan drew a superb shot with his last bowl to hold a one-shot advantage. Then stepped up Robert Grant, who played a driving shot to hit Girvan's bowl, which in turn pushed the jack into the ditch for the Scottish to win by a shot.

The drive apparently boosted the moral of the Scots and they were always in front in the second set. In the fourth end when the score was close at 3:2, Grant showed his class delivering another great bowl when they were one down to take a four. From then there was no way back for the New Zealand team and the second set finished 12:4.

Another piece of history was written as Kelsey Cottrell became the first woman to win three Hong Kong International Bowls Classic Pairs title on the Finals day.

Cottrell, a 23-year-old student from New South Wales, won the competition with Julie Keegan in 2009 and 2010. This time she did it with new partner Carla Odgers, after beating Val Smith and Mandy Boyd from New Zealand in the Final.



Throughout the whole competition, the Australian team only lost one game, which was against Singapore in the first game of the round-robin stage.

After that they were invincible and beat all other teams to top their group. They met England's Sandy Hazell and Annalisa Bellamy in the Semi-finals and beat them







from behind to reach the Final to face New Zealand.

New Zealand won all their games in the round-robin stage and beat Scotland's Anne Dunwoodie and Lorraine Malloy comfortably in the Semi-finals.

The Aussies knew their old rivals so well that they decided to stretch the head a bit longer in the hope that it would put Smith and Boyd out of rhythm. And it proved that the strategy worked quite well because Smith was seemingly out of depth throughout the game and this piled huge pressure on 21-year-old skipper Boyd.

Despite the score being tied at 5-5 after six ends, the Australians picked up the

momentum and won the last three ends to take the set.

In the second set, the Australians kept their good form by taking three shots in the first end, which put their opponents under a lot of pressure to come back.

The Aussies quickly opened up a lead of 10:1 after five ends, but the determined Kiwis fought back strongly to take seven shots in the next two ends. After dropping the three and the four, Cottrell and Odgers kept their composure and stayed calm. With two ends to go they took one shot each from the next two ends to win the title.

The best of the local girls were Camilla Leung and Winnie Au of the sponsor team which had earned a berth in the play-off only to be defeated by England 11:4, 7:5.

that is correct, the green is actually on a slope).

Singles aside, the main event is the Pairs. With 11 rounds to be played it is one very long and exhausting week. But the Hong Kong organisers always think of every detail and provide us with a rest day to put our feet up.

Feet up? No way we had a lot of shopping to do and shop till we drop is what we did.

In hope of refilling our wallets we headed to the happy Valley races that night to get in amongst the atmosphere. I'm not sure how everyone else went but my wallet was suffering beyond return by the end of the night. My theory of the funniest horse name equals the fastest horse wasn't quite a money-earner.

Back to the bowls, Kelsey and I managed to progress into top spot at the end of round 11 and enjoyed a bye straight into the semi-final.

Our boys finished third and matched

up in a quarter-final against New Zealand. We took out the first set then witnessed a showcase of top quality bowls in the second and tie-breaker where by neither team score greater than a single shot on each end. However the Kiwis managed to get that one shot more in the tie-breaker to progress to the semi-final. The eventual winner of the men's was Scotland who out classed the Kiwis in the Final.

Kelsey and I got over England in our semi-final tie breaker and then sneaked in a straight set win against the New Zealand women in the final to become the gold medalist and happiest girls in Hong Kong.

We had to celebrate and what better way than hitting the dance floor all night long with our abundance of new international friends.

Now home it's fair to say I'm absolutely exhausted but enjoyed a tremendous week thanks to my teammates and the extremely hospitable Hong Kong organisers who will do anything they can think of to make sure you enjoy the event.

### Youth Novice Competition

This competition was open to young bowlers aged under 25 and was successfully held at the Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre on 9, 16 and 23 March 2014. A total of 44 participants took part in the event, most of them are players under our Young Athletes Scheme (YAS). They achieved excellent results. The champion was Law Chung Kan, 1st runner-up was Chow Ho Yin, 2nd runner-up was Tse Tun Laam.



### Young Athletes Scheme

Launched in April 2006, the Scheme continues with the subvention from Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD). The 5 centres are located in Causeway Bay Victoria Park, Ap Lei Chau, Tseung Kwan O Hang Hau, Shatin Siu Lek Yuen Road and Tuen Mun Wu Shan bowling greens. There were a total of 44 and 45 participants for Phase 1 and Phase 2 respectively in 2013/2014. After the completion of this year's scheme, 4 players were promoted to our Youth Development Team.

### Inter-school Competition

With support from LCSD and Southern District Council in 2009 for the first time, this competition was successfully held again at the Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre on 1 May 2013. A total of 24 teams with 18 primary and 68 secondary students took part in the competition. The champion was Yan Oi Tong Tin Ka Ping Secondary School, 1st runner-up was Po Leung Kok C.W.C. College and 2nd runner-up was Yan Chai Hospital No.2 Secondary School.



### Pre-youth Squad Training

With subvention from LCSD, the pre-youth squad training programme was introduced in May 2012. This year, 12 young athletes were selected from the Young Athletes Scheme to undergo a 36-week systematic regular training at Ap Lei Chau Sports Centre on Saturday mornings.

### Under-25 Age Group Championship

This competition was held in July at Hang Hau Man Kuk Lane Park Bowling Green. A total of 86 youngsters took part in the event. This event is organized by the HKLBA and sponsored by the LCSD and Pokka Corporation (HK) Limited.



### School Sports Programme

The Association joined the School Sports Programme in May 2011 with LCSD's support. 34 School Demonstration, 11 I-Smart Fitness Scheme and 4 Outreach Coaching programmes were conducted in 2013/2014. Around 2000 students benefited from this programme.

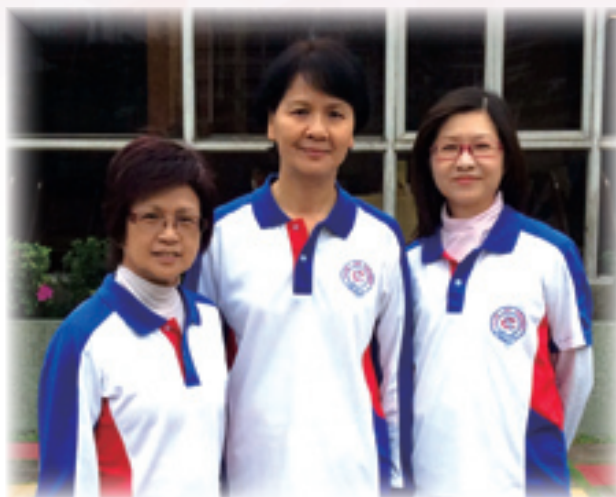

## *National Championships Panel Operations Report*

The major task of the new Panel was to review the Bowler of the Year points structure and draft the 2014 National Championships and Competitions Schedule taking into account the review findings.

After the review, Classic Singles and Qualifying have replaced Knock-out Singles and 2-4-2 Pairs to join the four traditional formats with re-aligned points to decide the BOTY Award.

The popular practice to alternate Premier Championships on Sundays for each gender between morning and afternoon sessions within a season and between seasons was reinstated in the 2014 Schedule to provide equal playing opportunities for all bowlers.

Towards the end of the season, the Panel amended the 2013 Schedule it inherited to remove an unviable date for 2-4-2 Pairs on the third day of the Chinese New Year and in response to Women's Knock-out Singles rained off on its original date in December and the unprecedented HK Squad overseas training which necessitated idling two Sundays in February 2014.

The new Panel also refined conditions of play of events to improve the game. This included application of the re-spotting rule in the Knock-out Singles and Aitkenhead Fours, as well as changing Champion of Champions to set play to resemble the worldwide version.

On the awards front, the Panel extended distribution of prize money to all quarter-finalists in the Aitkenhead to uphold its "sport for all" theme. The Panel also sourced higher quality silverware for trophy winners.

My personal thanks to CCC, CdeR, FC, HKCC, HKFC, HKPBC, IRC, KBGC, KCC and USRC for allowing use of their greens to make the Knock-out Singles, Semi-finals and National Championships Finals Days possible.

I would also like to thank all Officers and Panel members for their guidance and advice; to all Umpires and helpers; and special thanks to Howard Poon, a most dedicated worker, who has helped made my job easier.

Looking ahead, the Panel will focus on the following areas:

- Continued improvement of the National Schedule.
- Entries fee and prize money distribution schedule review.
- Bye-laws review with a view to improve clarity and to bring them up to date.
- Feasibility to utilize weekdays outside Tuesday and Sunday.
- Feasibility to reinstate or introduce new events.
- Draw algorithm review with a view to minimise the so-called home green advantage.

Last but not least, the Panel will continue to conduct its business in a professional manner. The practice to deal with bowler cases on demand and report significant cases to the Council will be carried on.
