Conditions of Play

1. Tournament date, time and venue:

<u>Day 1 – Sunday 15th December 2024 – Kai Tak Station Square Lawn Bowling Green</u> All participants are requested to report to organiser BEFORE 8.45 a.m.

<u>Day 2 – Sunday 22nd December 2024 – Kai Tak Station Square Lawn Bowling Green</u> All participants are requested to report to organiser BEFORE 8.45 a.m.

Players and Markers are then required to be ready for play at the allocated rink at the scheduled time for each match. No grace period is allowed. Late-comers, including as Markers, will be disqualified for the tournament.

No official meal break is scheduled in the fixtures. Participants are advised to make arrangement between matches.

2. Marker arrangement:

Day 1

All Players are required to act as Markers as fixture. Any Player who fails to oblige will be disqualified for the tournament.

Day 2

All Players are required to act as Markers as fixture, and also at the discretion of the Duty Umpire in knock out stage. Any Player who fails to oblige will be disqualified for the tournament.

For subsequent sessions, losing players in round robin stage and knock out stage will act as Markers. Appointment of Markers is at the discretion of the Duty Umpire. A Player may be required to mark for more than one match.

3. Dress code and footwear:

Players and Markers are required to wear proper lawn bowls attire, namely predominantly white or blue shorts, trousers or skirts, and collared shirts or affiliated club bowling shirts and proper lawn bowls shoes. Any undergarment or protective sleeves must be white in colour or of the same main colour as the shirt.

4. Competition format:

Round-robin sectional play followed by knock-outs.

In the men's section, 39 players are drawn into 8 groups for round-robin sectional play on Day 1. Top 2 players of each group will progress through to knock-out play on Day 2.

In the women's section, 29 players are drawn into 6 groups for round-robin sectional play on Day 1. Top player of each group plus two best seconds will progress through to knock-out play on Day 2.

For round-robin sectional play, 2 game points will be awarded for each match won and 1 point for a tie. All results of a disqualified player will be expunged.

For Group N are 4 players group, 2 games points and average shots difference will be awarded for each player for finding out best second players.

At the completion of the round-robin, Players will be ranked within each group in the order of:-

- Higher number of Game Points;
- Higher number of Shots Difference (Total Shots For minus Total Shots Against);
- Higher number of Shots For;
- Higher number of Shots Against;
- Winner of the match between the Players concerned;
- Toss of coin.

The draw for knock-out play on Day 2 will be conducted by the Duty Umpire 15 minutes before the start of the relevant sessions.

5. Match format

Four bowls per Player.

A time limit of 55 minutes or first to 15 for Day 1 and Day 2. If the match is a tie when the time is up in knock-out matches, an extra end will be played.

Trial end is allowed for first game of both days.

No visit to the head until after the delivery of a Player's third bowl.

No dead ends. A jack out of bound will be re-spotted on the centre line with the nearest point of the jack to the mat line at a spot which is 2 metres from the front ditch, commonly known as "T".

- 6. Players are reminded to observe venue regulations at all times.
- 7. In any event, the decision of the duty umpire is final.
- 8. In the case of green closure, any remaining fixtures will be rescheduled. Players are responsible to check the updated fixtures at LBA website.
